



PhD Program in Architecture 2018/2019 "Representation and Representativeness"

The Doctoral Programme in Architecture promotes a training methodology and learning environment appropriate to update and improve the acquisition of new skills in the different expertise areas, essential to the construction of a research autonomous pathway by the students.

The 2018/2019 edition of the Doctoral Program in Architecture, will be open under the theme: Representation and Representativeness and it will be coordinated by Prof. Pedro Bandeira, Associate Professor of EAUM.

According to Prof. Pedro Bandeira "This theme intends to reflect on the means of representation going along with thinking and doing of architecture in its different phases. At the centre is the image as a vehicle but also a privileged place for comprehensive communication. From a circular structure, it is proposed to develop a reflection on the image reminiscent and evocative of a past, and the prescient and evocative image of a future, meaning, between its analytical nature and its projectual nature.

It is proposed to investigate the methodologies of representation and its influence in the construction of architectural narratives. In summary, we can ask, provocatively, could there be architecture without representation?

2. Formal Requirements

May apply to the Doctoral Program in Architecture:

- a) The holder of a Master's degree or legal equivalent;
- b) Holders of a degree, with at least 300 credits, holders of an academic and scientific especially relevant that is recognized as attesting the capacity to carry out the PhD by the Scientific Council of "Architecture School," after consulting the Steering Committee;
- c) Holders of a school curriculum, scientific or professional recognized as attesting the capacity to carry out the PhD by the Scientific Council, after consulting with the Steering Committee.

The recognition referred to in subparagraphs b) and c) above has the effect only access to the course of study leading to the PhD degree and does not confer on its holder, the equivalence of the degree of bachelor or master, or recognition.
